RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department issued a press release yesterday evening saying that they have discovered two more cases of COVID-19 in their area. One was from Richardson County and one was from Pawnee County. The total number of cases in the area is listed below.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 13,127,030 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 12,934,317 cases. There have been 573,664 deaths. Yesterday there had been 569,697 deaths.

In the United States there are now 3,364,704 positive cases, 135,615 deaths and 41,004,275 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 3,304,942 cases, 135,205 deaths and 40,282,176 people that had been tested. There were 59,762 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 12,600 new cases were discovered in Florida alone.

In Nebraska there are now 21,399 cases and there have been 288 deaths. Yesterday there had been 21,172 positive cases and 285 deaths. That makes 227 new confirmed cases identified since yesterday and 89 of the new cases are in Douglas County. 211,659 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 208,103 people had been tested. We now have had five confirmed cases in Nemaha County, one in Pawnee County, nine in Richardson County, seven in Johnson County and twenty-six in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 8,113 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,624 confirmed cases in Hall County, 878 cases in Dawson County and 1,792 cases in Dakota County. There are now 65 cases in Gage County and 2,171 cases in Lancaster County. There have been 48 positive cases and one death in the Southeast District Health Department area.
