**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department issued a press release on Wednesday, August 5<sup>th</sup>, announcing that there have been five more cases of COVID-19 discovered in the district. Four of the cases were in Nemaha County and one was in Pawnee County. The total number of cases in each county in the district are listed below.

Nemaha County Hospital, along with three other hospitals in Southeast Nebraska, plan to become testing sites for TestNebraska. As more information becomes available I will share it with you.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 18,847,261 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 18,576,034. There have been 708,469 deaths. Yesterday there had been 701,316 deaths.

In the United States there are now 4,825,742 positive cases, 158,300 deaths and 58,920,975 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 4,771,846 cases, 156,839 deaths and 58,239,438 people that had been tested. There were 53,896 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 1,461 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 27,489 cases and there have been 340 deaths. Yesterday there had been 27,178 positive cases and 332 deaths. 311 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 156 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 287,105 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 283,859 people had been tested. We now have had twenty-four confirmed cases in Nemaha County, nine in Pawnee County, twenty in Richardson County, thirteen in Johnson County and forty-two in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 10,875 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,727 confirmed cases in Hall County, 951 cases in Dawson County and 1,908 cases in Dakota County. There are now 83 cases in Gage County and 3,180 cases in Lancaster County. There have been 108 positive cases and one death in the Southeast District Health Department area.
