**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, August 26<sup>th</sup>. There are nine new cases in their area. There were three additional cases in Nemaha County, two additional case in Richardson County and four additional cases in Otoe County. This makes a total of 216 cases and two deaths in the district. 131 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days.

Nemaha County Hospital will be staffing a Test Nebraska site next Tuesday, September 1<sup>st</sup> from 10:00 until noon. Thanks to everyone that volunteered to help with this effort. Please see flyers and social media for additional information.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 24,203,260 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 23,930,649. There have been 826,418 deaths. Yesterday there had been 820,286 deaths.

In the United States there are now 5,823,923 positive cases, 179,743 deaths and 74,549,129 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 5,779,707 cases, 178,535 deaths and 73,535,820 people that had been tested. There were 44,216 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 1,208 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 32,727 cases and there have been 386 deaths. Yesterday there had been 32,348 positive cases and 383 deaths. 379 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 129 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 340,481 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 340,481 people had been tested. We now have had sixty-two confirmed cases in Nemaha County, ten in Pawnee County, thirty-one in Richardson County, twenty-one in Johnson County and ninety-two in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 12,944 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,809 confirmed cases in Hall County, 993 cases in Dawson County and 1,971 cases in Dakota County. There are now 125 cases in Gage County and 3,720 cases in Lancaster County.
