RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Friday, August 28th. There are thirty-two new cases in their area. There were fifteen additional cases in Nemaha County, two additional case in Richardson County, one new case in Johnson County and fourteen additional cases in Otoe County. This makes a total of 254 cases and two deaths in the district. 165 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days.

Nemaha County Hospital will be staffing a Test Nebraska site tomorrow, September 1st from 10:00 until noon. Thanks to everyone that volunteered to help with this effort. Please see flyers and social media for additional information.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 25,251,916 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 25,038,901. There have been 846,961 deaths. Yesterday there had been 843,243 deaths.

In the United States there are now 5,997,861 positive cases, 183,068 deaths and 77,591,123 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 5,962,057 cases, 182,785 deaths and 76,849,918 people that had been tested. There were 35,804 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 283 deaths. It always seems as though there is less reporting done over the weekend, thus the lower numbers of cases and deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 34,046 cases and there have been 392 deaths. Yesterday there had been 33,753 positive cases and 392 deaths. 293 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 93 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 357,745 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 355,218 people had been tested. We now have had seventy-seven confirmed cases in Nemaha County, ten in Pawnee County, thirty-three in Richardson County, twenty-two in Johnson County and 106 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 13,431 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,843 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,002 cases in Dawson County and 2,000 cases in Dakota County. There are now 125 cases in Gage County and 3,990 cases in Lancaster County.
