RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Monday, August 31st. There are twenty-three new cases in their area. There were six additional cases in Nemaha County, six additional case in Richardson County, one new case in Pawnee County and ten additional cases in Otoe County. This makes a total of 271 cases and two deaths in the district. 172 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 25,511,385 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 25,251,916. There have been 851,154 deaths. Yesterday there had been 846,961 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,031,424 positive cases, 183,602 deaths and 78,292,321 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 5,997,861 cases, 183,068 deaths and 77,591,123 people that had been tested. There were 33,563 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 534 deaths. We now have more than six million confirmed cases in United States.

In Nebraska there are now 34,287 cases and there have been 397 deaths. Yesterday there had been 34,046 positive cases and 392 deaths. 241 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 51 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 361,351 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 357,745 people had been tested. We now have had eighty-three confirmed cases in Nemaha County, eleven in Pawnee County, thirty-nine in Richardson County, twenty-two in Johnson County and 116 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 13,482 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,849 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,005 cases in Dawson County and 2,010 cases in Dakota County. There are now 132 cases in Gage County and 4,050 cases in Lancaster County.
