RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. We had a good day yesterday with our first day of collecting tests for Test Nebraska. The team collected twenty-one samples and delivered them to the lab in Lincoln. Thanks to all of the volunteers that assisted with this event and a special thanks to Diane for her leadership and for delivering the samples to Lincoln. We will be doing this again next Tuesday.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 25,785,890 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 25,511,385. There have been 857,821 deaths. Yesterday there had been 851,154 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,076,425 positive cases, 184,697 deaths and 78,996,267 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 6,031,424 cases, 183,602 deaths and 78,292,321 people that had been tested. There were 45,001 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 1,095 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 34,574 cases and there have been 399 deaths. Yesterday there had been 34,287 positive cases and 397 deaths. 287 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 77 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 363,075 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 361,351 people had been tested. We now have had eighty-three confirmed cases in Nemaha County, eleven in Pawnee County, thirty-nine in Richardson County, twenty-two in Johnson County and 116 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 13,559 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,859 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,009 cases in Dawson County and 2,013 cases in Dakota County. There are now 133 cases in Gage County and 4,102 cases in Lancaster County.
