**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>. There are seventeen new cases in their area. There were six additional cases in Nemaha County, one additional case in Richardson County, one new case in Pawnee County, three additional cases in Johnson County and six additional cases in Otoe County. This makes a total of 288 cases and two deaths in the district. 185 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 26,065,382 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 25,785,890. There have been 863,826 deaths. Yesterday there had been 857,821 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,115,638 positive cases, 185,756 deaths and 79,646,008 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 6,076,425 cases, 184,697 deaths and 78,996,267 people that had been tested. There were 39,213 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 1,059 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 34,995 cases and there have been 399 deaths. Yesterday there had been 34,574 positive cases and 399 deaths. 423 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 112 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 365,641 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 363,075 people had been tested. We now have had eighty-nine confirmed cases in Nemaha County, twelve in Pawnee County, forty in Richardson County, twenty-five in Johnson County and 122 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 13,671 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,866 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,012 cases in Dawson County and 2,021 cases in Dakota County. There are now 137 cases in Gage County and 4,213 cases in Lancaster County.
