RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Friday, September 4th. There are eleven new cases in their area. There were seven additional cases in Nemaha County, one additional case in Johnson County and three additional cases in Otoe County. This makes a total of 299 cases and two deaths in the district. 191 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

If you look at the statistics that were reported over the holiday weekend, it is obvious that most testing sites were not open, thus the number of positive cases identified is down dramatically. I believe that this happened across the nation and not just in our state. Please don't interpret this trend as things are improving. Let's wait and see what the data shows later this week.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 27,364,931 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 27,146,371. There have been 893,219 deaths. Yesterday there had been 889,364 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,301,649 positive cases, 189,219 deaths and 83,426,990 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 6,277,947 cases, 188,942 deaths and 82,838,081 people that had been tested. There were 23,702 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 277 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 35,975 cases and there have been 404 deaths. Yesterday there had been 35,886 positive cases and 404 deaths. 89 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 20 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 377,461 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 376,828 people had been tested. We now have had ninety-six confirmed cases in Nemaha County, twelve in Pawnee County, forty in Richardson County, twenty-six in Johnson County and 125 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 13,939 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,885 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,026 cases in Dawson County and 2,056 cases in Dakota County. There are now 140 cases in Gage County and 4,417 cases in Lancaster County.
