RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Tuesday, September 8th. There are ten new cases in their area. There were two additional cases in Nemaha County, three additional cases in Johnson County, four additional cases in Richardson County, and two additional cases in Otoe County. There was a correction to the data which removed one case attributed to Pawnee County. They are shown as now having eleven cases when they were shown to have twelve cases yesterday. This makes a total of 309 cases and two deaths in the district. 185 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

The state data shows a large correction in the number of cases reported yesterday. I don't believe this reflects what happened in the state yesterday. I believe that some of the cases reported yesterday were actually discovered earlier. Probably the best way to review the data is to look at a ten-day moving average.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 27,615,676 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 27,364,931. There have been 898,426 deaths. Yesterday there had been 893,219 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,329,861 positive cases, 189,699 deaths and 83,964,567 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 6,301,649 cases, 189,219 deaths and 83,426,990 people that had been tested. There were 28,212 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 480 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 36,469 cases and there have been 407 deaths. Yesterday there had been 35,975 positive cases and 404 deaths. 494 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 103 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 378,300 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 377,461 people had been tested. We now have had ninety-eight confirmed cases in Nemaha County, eleven in Pawnee County, forty-four in Richardson County, twenty-nine in Johnson County and 127 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 14,042 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,889 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,035 cases in

Dawson County and 2,058 cases in Dakota County. There are now 146 cases in Gage County and 4,582 cases in Lancaster County.
