RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. Across the nation we are seeing a spike in cases on college campuses. I have noticed a pretty steep rise in cases in Lancaster County so I wonder if this can be attributed to the cases at UNL? I was also told yesterday by the Southeast District Health Department that the positive cases at Peru State College are attributed to Nemaha County, which could account for some, but not all of the new cases here.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 28,205,308 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 27,902,002. There have been 910,157 deaths. Yesterday there had been 904,485 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,397,629 positive cases, 191,522 deaths and 85,181,078 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 6,365,595 cases, 190,887 deaths and 84,558,560 people that had been tested. There were 32,034 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 635 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 37,373 cases and there have been 430 deaths. Yesterday there had been 36,917 positive cases and 421 deaths. 456 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 104 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 390,318 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 385,349 people had been tested. We now have had 102 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, eleven in Pawnee County, forty-eight in Richardson County, twenty-nine in Johnson County and 127 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 14,262 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,908 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,039 cases in Dawson County and 2,070 cases in Dakota County. There are now 157 cases in Gage County and 4,863 cases in Lancaster County.
