RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Friday, September 11th. There are ten new cases in their area. There were six additional cases in Nemaha County, one additional case in Johnson County, one additional case in Richardson County, and two additional cases in Otoe County. This makes a total of 327 cases and two deaths in the district. 181 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

Again, the data looks a little inconsistent after the weekend. The numbers look low compared with earlier in the week and the seven-day averages. Also there was a correction in the number of deaths in the state, which always looks strange.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 29,032,938 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 28,789,698. There have been 924,831 deaths. Yesterday there had been 920,808 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,520,733 positive cases, 194,625 deaths and 88,819,861 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 6,486,469 cases, 193,705 deaths and 88,048,386 people that had been tested. There were 34,264 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 920 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 38,188 cases and there have been 434 deaths. Yesterday there had been 38,120 positive cases and 437 deaths. 68 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 38 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 400,684 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 397,354 people had been tested. We now have had 108 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, eleven in Pawnee County, forty-nine in Richardson County, thirty in Johnson County and 129 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 14,448 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,917 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,046 cases in Dawson County and 2,081 cases in Dakota County. There are now 163 cases in Gage County and 5,086 cases in Lancaster County.
