RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Monday, September 14th. There are six new cases in their area. There was one additional cases in Nemaha County, two additional cases in Johnson County, one additional case in Richardson County, one additional case in Pawnee County and one additional case in Otoe County. This makes a total of 333 cases and two deaths in the district. 169 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

It appears that the data has corrected itself from the reports over the weekend. This is consistent with what I see every weekend. It will be interesting to see what happens with the new cases in the state with the governor relaxing the social distancing requirements. The trend line shows that the number of cases is rising in the state now.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 29,316,738 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 29,032,938. There have been 929,236 deaths. Yesterday there had been 924,831 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,555,408 positive cases, 194,547 deaths and 89,603,688 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 6,520,733 cases, 194,265 deaths and 88,819,861 people that had been tested. There were 34,675 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 282 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 38,642 cases and there have been 435 deaths. Yesterday there had been 38,188 positive cases and 434 deaths. 454 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 114 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 400,684 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 400,684 people had been tested. We now have had 109 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, twelve in Pawnee County, fifty in Richardson County, thirty-two in Johnson County and 130 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 14,563 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,922 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,052 cases in Dawson County and 2,085 cases in Dakota County. There are now 169 cases in Gage County and 5,186 cases in Lancaster County.
