RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. Well, it sounds like the Big 10 is now going to play football this fall. It will be interesting to see what happens when we all get together to cheer on the Big Red.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 29,611,845 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 29,316,738. There have been 935,929 deaths. Yesterday there had been 929,236 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,606,859 positive cases, 195,961 deaths and 89,987,708 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 6,555,408 cases, 194,547 deaths and 89,603,688 people that had been tested. There were 51,451 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 1,414 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 38,970 cases and there have been 436 deaths. Yesterday there had been 38,642 positive cases and 435 deaths. 328 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 85 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 406,675 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 403,965 people had been tested. We now have had 109 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, twelve in Pawnee County, fifty in Richardson County, thirty-two in Johnson County and 130 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 14,648 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,932 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,055 cases in Dawson County and 2,086 cases in Dakota County. There are now 172 cases in Gage County and 5,267 cases in Lancaster County.
