RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, September 16th. There are twelve new cases in their area. There were five additional cases in Nemaha County, two additional cases in Johnson County, two additional cases in Richardson County and three additional cases in Otoe County. This makes a total of 345 cases and two deaths in the district. 166 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

I would like to remind you once again to check on those that are your friends or relatives and that are socially isolated for various reasons. Loneliness is a terrible disease and it is something we can impact.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 29,910,816 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 29,611,845. There have been 941,381 deaths. Yesterday there had been 935,929 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,631,751 positive cases, 196,842 deaths and 90,710,730 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 6,606,859 cases, 195,961 deaths and 89,987,708 people that had been tested. There were 24,892 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 881 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 39,419 cases and there have been 439 deaths. Yesterday there had been 38,970 positive cases and 436 deaths. 449 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 103 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 408,961 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 406,675 people had been tested. We now have had 114 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, twelve in Pawnee County, fifty-two in Richardson County, thirty-four in Johnson County and 133 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 14,751 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,939 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,058 cases in Dawson County and 2,110 cases in Dakota County. There are now 176 cases in Gage County and 5,349 cases in Lancaster County.
