RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Monday, September 21st. There are thirteen new cases in their area. There were seven additional case in Nemaha County, two additional cases in Johnson County, one additional case in Richardson County and three additional cases in Otoe County. This makes a total of 370 cases and two deaths in the district. 160 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 31,361,979 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 31,103,347. There have been 965,642 deaths. Yesterday there had been 961,435 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,859,117 positive cases, 199,911 deaths and 95,841,281 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 6,813,984 cases, 199,525 deaths and 95,108,559 people that had been tested. There were 45,133 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 386 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 41,388 cases and there have been 452 deaths. Yesterday there had been 41,083 positive cases and 442 deaths. 305 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 54 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 425,816 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 423,360 people had been tested. We now have had 122 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, twelve in Pawnee County, fifty-six in Richardson County, thirty-eight in Johnson County and 142 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 15,238 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,963 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,068 cases in Dawson County and 2,155 cases in Dakota County. There are now 206 cases in Gage County and 5,737 cases in Lancaster County.
