RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, September 23rd. There are fourteen new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There were two additional case in Nemaha County, three additional cases in Johnson County, three additional cases in Richardson County, two additional cases in Pawnee County and four additional cases in Otoe County. This makes a total of 384 cases and two deaths in the district. 172 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

Again I want to remind you to be kind to people around you. Everyone is under a lot of stress these days and they may say or do things that they normally wouldn't. You don't have to take any abuse, but you might cut them a little slack. Also, be mindful of those that are socially isolated. Loneliness is a terrible disease.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 31,932,867 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 31,657,930. There have been 977,453 deaths. Yesterday there had been 971,915 deaths.

In the United States there are now 6,935,799 positive cases, 201,920 deaths and 97,459,742 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 6,897,756 cases, 200,818 deaths and 96,612,436 people that had been tested. There were 38,043 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 1,102 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 42,278 cases and there have been 462 deaths. Yesterday there had been 41,785 positive cases and 461 deaths. 493 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 146 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 431,102 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 428,046 people had been tested. We now have had 124 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, fourteen in Pawnee County, fifty-nine in Richardson County, forty-one in Johnson County and 146 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 15,495 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 1,979 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,071 cases in Dawson County and 2,176 cases in Dakota County. There are now 212 cases in Gage County and 5,906 cases in Lancaster County.
