**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Monday, September 28<sup>th</sup>. There are 28 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There were two additional cases in Nemaha County, 13 additional cases in Johnson County, two additional cases in Richardson County, one additional case in Pawnee County and ten additional cases in Otoe County. This makes a total of 427 cases and two deaths in the district. 164 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 33,417,386 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 33,145,948. There have been 1,002,864 deaths. Yesterday there had been 998,489 deaths. You may notice that deaths from COVID-19 in the world now exceeds one million!

In the United States there are now 7,150,824 positive cases, 205,107 deaths and 102,342,416 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 7,117,116 cases, 204,762 deaths and 101,298,794 people that had been tested. There were 33,708 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 345 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 44,578 cases and there have been 472 deaths. Yesterday there had been 44,063 positive cases and 470 deaths. 515 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 137 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 448,361 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 445,129 people had been tested. We now have had 129 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 17 in Pawnee County, 61 in Richardson County, 59 in Johnson County and 161 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 16,150 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 2,018 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,086 cases in Dawson County and 2,217 cases in Dakota County. There are now 255 cases in Gage County and 6,313 cases in Lancaster County.
