RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. These are interesting times in the COVID-19 pandemic. Cases continue to rise across the state, especially in rural locations. The number of hospitalizations in the state also continues to rise. I hope this trend resolves before we enter the flu season. By the way, be sure to get your flu shot as soon as possible.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 33,706,888 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 33,417,386. There have been 1,008,993 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,002,864 deaths.

In the United States there are now 7,191,519 positive cases, 206,005 deaths and 103,155,189 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 7,150,824 cases, 205,107 deaths and 102,342,416 people that had been tested. There were 40,695 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 898 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 45,044 cases and there have been 478 deaths. Yesterday there had been 44,578 positive cases and 472 deaths. 466 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 133 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 452,557 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 448,361 people had been tested. We now have had 129 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 17 in Pawnee County, 61 in Richardson County, 59 in Johnson County and 161 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 16,283 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 2,033 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,090 cases in Dawson County and 2,225 cases in Dakota County. There are now 260 cases in Gage County and 6,388 cases in Lancaster County.
