RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Friday, October 2nd. There are 38 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There were 11 additional cases in Nemaha County, six additional cases in Johnson County and 13 additional cases in Otoe County, two cases from the total for Pawnee County and six additional cases from Richardson County. This makes a total of 475 cases and three deaths in the district. 182 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 35,238,623 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 34,958,150. There have been 1,037,027 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,034,101 deaths.

In the United States there are now 7,419,594 positive cases, 209,734 deaths and 107,874,833 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 7,384,422 cases, 209,401 deaths and 106,940,107 people that had been tested. There were 35,172 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 333 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 47,807 cases and there have been 501 deaths. Yesterday there had been 47,403 positive cases and 497 deaths. 404 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 151 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 473,353 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 469,968 people had been tested. We now have had 143 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 18 in Pawnee County, 67 in Richardson County, 68 in Johnson County and 179 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 17,075 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 2,079 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,108 cases in Dawson County and 2,301 cases in Dakota County. There are now 297 cases in Gage County and 6,790 cases in Lancaster County.
