RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Monday, October 5th. There are 21 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There were five additional cases in Nemaha County, three additional cases in Johnson County and 12 additional cases in Otoe County, one additional case in Pawnee County and no additional cases from Richardson County. This makes a total of 496 cases and three deaths in the district. 191 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days. I encourage you to go to the Southeast District Health Department website's dashboard where there is much more information on the cases in this area.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 35,536,634 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 35,238,623. There have been 1,044,884 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,037,027 deaths.

In the United States there are now 7,459,101 positive cases, 210,195 deaths and 108,831,227 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 7,419,594 cases, 209,734 deaths and 107,874,833 people that had been tested. There were 39,507 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 461 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 48,259 cases and there have been 503 deaths. Yesterday there had been 47,807 positive cases and 501 deaths. 452 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 99 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 476,952 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 473,353 people had been tested. We now have had 148 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 19 in Pawnee County, 67 in Richardson County, 71 in Johnson County and 191 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 17,174 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 2,084 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,109 cases in Dawson County and 2,315 cases in Dakota County. There are now 297 cases in Gage County and 6,862 cases in Lancaster County.
