**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, October 7<sup>th</sup>. There are 16 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There were four additional cases in Nemaha County, zero additional cases in Johnson County, seven additional cases in Otoe County, zero additional case in Pawnee County and five additional cases in Richardson County. This makes a total of 512 cases and three deaths in the district. 203 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 36,234,307 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 35,865,117. There have been 1,057,043 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,050,821 deaths.

In the United States there are now 7,554,434 positive cases, 211,905 deaths and 111,077,086 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 7,502,004 cases, 210,918 deaths and 109,646,837 people that had been tested. There were 52,430 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 987 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 49,396 cases and there have been 507 deaths. Yesterday there had been 48,757 positive cases and 507 deaths. 639 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 181 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 485,994 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 481,013 people had been tested. We now have had 152 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 19 in Pawnee County, 72 in Richardson County, 71 in Johnson County and 198 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 17,533 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 2,108 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,111 cases in Dawson County and 2,337 cases in Dakota County. There are now 309 cases in Gage County and 6,996 cases in Lancaster County.
