**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Friday, October 16<sup>th</sup>. There are 33 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There were six additional cases in Nemaha County, two additional cases in Johnson County, 16 additional cases in Otoe County, three additional cases in Pawnee County and six additional cases in Richardson County. This makes a total of 623 cases and three deaths in the district. 278 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days.

The governor came out with new directed health measures on Friday that go into effect on Wednesday, the 21<sup>st</sup>. I hope they are not too little, too late.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 40,118,314 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 39,745,033. There have been 1,114,715 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,110,843 deaths.

In the United States there are now 8,156,107 positive cases, 219,680 deaths and 124,793,756 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 8,107,648 cases, 219,311 deaths and 123,830,950 people that had been tested. There were 48,459 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 369 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 58,068 cases and there have been 548 deaths. Yesterday there had been 57,334 positive cases and 548 deaths. 734 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 226 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 539,127 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 535,347 people had been tested. We now have had 170 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 22 in Pawnee County, 93 in Richardson County, 83 in Johnson County and 255 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 20,025 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 2,415 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,197 cases in Dawson County and 2,457 cases in Dakota County. There are now 436 cases in Gage County and 8,059 cases in Lancaster County.
