RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Monday, October 26th. There are 16 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There were two additional cases in Nemaha County, one additional case in Johnson County, six additional cases in Otoe County, no additional cases in Pawnee County and seven additional cases in Richardson County. This makes a total of 709 cases and three deaths in the district. 302 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 43,587,563 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 43,170,766. There have been 1,160,960 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,155,434 deaths.

In the United States there are now 8,705,340 positive cases, 225,765 deaths and 133,750,060 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 8,638,127 cases, 225,239 deaths and 132,568,375 people that had been tested. There were 67,213 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 526 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 64,499 cases and there have been 603 deaths. Yesterday there had been 63,797 positive cases and 596 deaths. 702 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 210 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 569,834 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 567,426 people had been tested. We now have had 185 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 24 in Pawnee County, 109 in Richardson County, 94 in Johnson County and 297 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 21,816 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 2,599 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,273 cases in Dawson County and 2,532 cases in Dakota County. There are now 530 cases in Gage County and 8,783 cases in Lancaster County.
