RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, October 28th. There are 43 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There were 10 additional cases in Nemaha County, two additional cases in Johnson County, seven additional cases in Otoe County, one additional case in Pawnee County and 23 additional cases in Richardson County. This makes a total of 752 cases and three deaths in the district. 327 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 44,586,424 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 44,081,789. There have been 1,175,712 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,168,824 deaths.

In the United States there are now 8,859,642 positive cases, 227,703 deaths and 139,513,001 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 8,781,354 cases, 226,752 deaths and 138,457,135 people that had been tested. There were 78,288 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 951 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 66,545 cases and there have been 628 deaths. Yesterday there had been 65,376 positive cases and 620 deaths. 1,169 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 300 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 577,023 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 572,760 people had been tested. We now have had 195 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 25 in Pawnee County, 132 in Richardson County, 96 in Johnson County and 304 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 22,381 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 2,656 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,291 cases in Dawson County and 2,545 cases in Dakota County. There are now 555 cases in Gage County and 8,981 cases in Lancaster County.
