RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, October 14th. There are 27 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There was one additional case in Nemaha County, four additional cases in Johnson County, 14 additional cases in Otoe County, one less case in Pawnee County than was listed before and nine additional cases in Richardson County. This makes a total of 590 cases and three deaths in the district. 253 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 38,588,292 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 38,207,395. There have been 1,093,359 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,087,470 deaths.

In the United States there are now 7,917,389 positive cases, 216,904 deaths and 118,368,930 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 7,860,281 cases, 215,955 deaths and 117,357,626 people that had been tested. There were 57,108 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 949 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 54,467 cases and there have been 530 deaths. Yesterday there had been 53,543 positive cases and 527 deaths. 949 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 228 of the new cases were in Douglas County. 519,411 people have been tested in the state. Yesterday 515,493 people had been tested. We now have had 164 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 19 in Pawnee County, 87 in Richardson County, 81 in Johnson County and 239 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 18,878 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 2,316 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,165 cases in Dawson County and 2,418 cases in Dakota County. There are now 362 cases in Gage County and 7,665 cases in Lancaster County.
