**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>. There are 20 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There were no additional cases in Nemaha County, no additional cases in Johnson County, 11 additional cases in Otoe County, no additional cases in Pawnee County and nine additional cases in Richardson County. This makes a total of 800 cases and three deaths in the district. 317 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 47,007,194 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 46,632,558. There have been 1,208,224 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,201,927 deaths.

In the United States there are now 9,296,159 positive cases, 231,591 deaths and 148,636,454 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 9,209,165 cases, 231,003 deaths and 147,218,569 people that had been tested. There were 86,994 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 588 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 72,620 cases and there have been 656 deaths. Yesterday there had been 71,666 positive cases and 654 deaths. 954 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 289 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 201 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 28 in Pawnee County, 155 in Richardson County, 96 in Johnson County and 320 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 23,894 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 2,805 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,377 cases in Dawson County and 2,614 cases in Dakota County. There are now 616 cases in Gage County and 9,743 cases in Lancaster County.
