**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, November 4<sup>th</sup>. There are 88 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There were 10 additional cases in Nemaha County, 11 additional cases in Johnson County, 43 additional cases in Otoe County, four additional cases in Pawnee County and 20 additional cases in Richardson County. This makes a total of 888 cases and three deaths in the district. 394 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 48,252,129 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 47,569,012. There have been 1,227,544 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,216,344 deaths.

In the United States there are now 9,492,599 positive cases, 233,767 deaths and 150,969,797 people that have been tested. Yesterday there were 9,387,400 cases, 232,657 deaths and 149,762,678 people that had been tested. There were 105,199 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 1,110 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 75,888 cases and there have been 669 deaths. Yesterday there had been 74,060 positive cases and 660 deaths. 1,828 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 485 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 211 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 32 in Pawnee County, 175 in Richardson County, 107 in Johnson County and 363 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 24,745 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 2,940 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,416 cases in Dawson County and 2,644 cases in Dakota County. There are now 665 cases in Gage County and 10,092 cases in Lancaster County.
