**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Monday, November 9<sup>th</sup>. There are 68 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There were 8 additional cases in Nemaha County, 8 additional cases in Johnson County, 30 additional cases in Otoe County, one additional case in Pawnee County and 21 additional cases in Richardson County. There has been one additional death in our area. This makes a total of 1092 cases and four deaths in the district. 544 of the cases were diagnosed in the last thirty days.

It appears that the Pfizer vaccine will be the first one to be sent to the FDA for approval. It also sounds like it gives an excellent response to recipients in the 90% range. It is going to be very important that those offered this vaccine agree to take it otherwise all of this effort is in vain.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 50,913,451 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 50,523,502. There have been 1,263,089 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,258,109 deaths.

In the United States there are now 10,110,552 positive cases, 238,251 deaths. Yesterday there were 9,973,666 cases, 237,584 deaths. There were 136,886 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 667 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 85,551 cases and there have been 710 deaths. Yesterday there had been 83,969 positive cases and 703 deaths. 1,582 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 559 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 263 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 34 in Pawnee County, 211 in Richardson County, 146 in Johnson County and 438 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 27,384 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 3,170 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,513 cases in Dawson County and 2,724 cases in Dakota County. There are now 774 cases in Gage County and 11,201 cases in Lancaster County.
