Good morning and thanks for reading this update. I just want to say how thankful I am for all of our wonderful staff today. We have some staff members that are ill or are out caring for a family member. This means that you are working short staffed. I appreciate you stepping up and supporting your co-workers. Susanne sent out a note asking members of our staff to say what they are thankful for concerning our hospital. It is amazing what everyone is saying but most of the responses state that they are thankful for the staff that they work with. All I can say is, "Me Too"! Have you also noticed how the conversations changes when we look at what is right with the world instead of what is wrong? Thanks again for all you do in these difficult times.

It is also time again to remind us all to check on those that cannot get out and may be living alone. Loneliness is a terrible disease. If you think of someone that may be alone, just give them a quick call. I guarantee it will be appreciated.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 52,289,705 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 51,621,135. There have been 1,286,926 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,274,661 deaths.

In the United States there are now 10,403,745 positive cases and 241,809 deaths. Yesterday there were 10,260,282 cases and 239,695 deaths. There were 143,463 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 2,114 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 89,942 cases and there have been 731 deaths. Yesterday there had been 87,733 positive cases and 730 deaths. 2,209 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 533 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 263 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 34 in Pawnee County, 211 in Richardson County, 146 in Johnson County and 438 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 28,603 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 3,350 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,587 cases in Dawson County and 2,759 cases in Dakota County. There are now 866 cases in Gage County and 11,778 cases in Lancaster County.
