**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Thursday, November 19<sup>th</sup>. There are 66 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There are six new cases in Nemaha County, two additional cases in Johnson County, 28 additional cases in Otoe County, three additional cases in Pawnee County and 27 additional cases in Richardson County. This makes a total of 1538 cases and four deaths in the district. 897 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 57,076,577 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 56,407,020. There have been 1,363,533 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,352,338 deaths.

In the United States there are now 11,725,093 positive cases and 252,599 deaths. Yesterday there were 11,531,743 cases and 250,579 deaths. There were 193,350 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 2,020 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 109,280 cases and there have been 854 deaths. Yesterday there had been 106,617 positive cases and 826 deaths. 2,663 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 791 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 301 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 54 in Pawnee County, 292 in Richardson County, 274 in Johnson County and 617 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 34,680 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 3,970 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,790 cases in Dawson County and 2,960 cases in Dakota County. There are now 1,102 cases in Gage County and 13,797 cases in Lancaster County.
