RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Friday, November 20th. There are 128 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. There are 36 new cases in Nemaha County, 23 additional cases in Johnson County, 46 additional cases in Otoe County, two additional cases in Pawnee County and 21 additional cases in Richardson County. This makes a total of 1666 cases and four deaths in the district. 996 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 58,795,765 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 58,274,308. There have been 1,390,262 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,382,745 deaths.

In the United States there are now 12,254,135 positive cases and 256,800 deaths. Yesterday there were 12,094,789 cases and 255,909 deaths. There were 159,346 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 891 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 114,061 cases and there have been 909 deaths. Yesterday there had been 113,029 positive cases and 905 deaths. 1,032 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 193 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 337 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 56 in Pawnee County, 313 in Richardson County, 297 in Johnson County and 663 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 35,854 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 4,147 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,858 cases in Dawson County and 3,024 cases in Dakota County. There are now 1,153 cases in Gage County and 14,507 cases in Lancaster County.
