RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Monday, November 30th. The district shows a total of 1904 cases and eight deaths in the district. 1,018 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

The Southeast District Health Department has changed their website and are showing much more information. You might want to log on and take a look.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 63,384,168 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 62,849,187. There have been 1,470,971 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,461,376 deaths.

In the United States there are now 13,546,787 positive cases and 268,103 deaths. Yesterday there were 13,389,786 cases and 266,887 deaths. There were 157,001 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 1,216 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 128,407 cases and there have been 1,018 deaths. Yesterday there had been 126,466 positive cases and 989 deaths. 1,941 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 660 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 364 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 80 in Pawnee County, 388 in Richardson County, 317 in Johnson County and 755 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 40,622 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 4,669 confirmed cases in Hall County, 1,986 cases in Dawson County and 3,159 cases in Dakota County. There are now 1,337 cases in Gage County and 16,735 cases in Lancaster County.
