RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning and thanks for reading this update. The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, December 2nd. The district shows a total of 2004 cases and 10 deaths in the district. 1,102 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 64,683,901 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 64,037,353. There have been 1,496,055 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,483,859 deaths.

In the United States there are now 13,931,901 positive cases and 273,848 deaths. Yesterday there were 13,730,738 cases and 270,728 deaths. There were 201,163 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 3,120 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 132,530 cases and there have been 1,128 deaths. Yesterday there had been 130,194 positive cases and 1,080 deaths. 2,336 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 642 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 399 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 88 in Pawnee County, 414 in Richardson County, 332 in Johnson County and 781 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 41,855 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 4,889 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,010 cases in Dawson County and 3,191 cases in Dakota County. There are now 1,400 cases in Gage County and 17,336 cases in Lancaster County.
