RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, January 6th. There are 63 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. 11 of the new cases are in Johnson County, 19 are in Nemaha County, 20 are in Otoe County, seven are in Pawnee County and six are in Richardson County. This makes a total of 2,968 cases and 34 deaths in the district. 711 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

Many people become somewhat depressed after the holidays. I suggest that you check on your family, friends and neighbors to make sure that they are ok. Caring for someone else will make you feel better as well!

As of 9:00 this morning there were 87,364,576 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 86,569,693. There have been 1,886,603 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,871,754 deaths.

In the United States there are now 21,307,125 positive cases and 361,312 deaths. Yesterday there were 21,055,486 cases and 357,422 deaths. There were 251,639 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 3,890 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 172,469 cases and there have been 1,703 deaths. Yesterday there had been 171,033 positive cases and 1,692 deaths. 1,436 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 478 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 601 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 171 in Pawnee County, 586 in Richardson County, 556 in Johnson County and 1,054 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 55,313 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 5,958 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,547 cases in Dawson County and 3,536 cases in Dakota County. There are now 1,876 cases in Gage County and 23,439 cases in Lancaster County.
