RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Friday, January 8th. There are 58 new cases of COVID-19 and four additional deaths in their area. 10 of the new cases are in Johnson County, 17 are in Nemaha County, 14 are in Otoe County, three are in Pawnee County and 14 are in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,026 cases and 38 deaths in the district. 682 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

The second round of vaccinations for front line employees begins today. If you received your first dose on December 21st, you are scheduled to get your second dose today. Please do so, if at all possible, or contact your supervisor.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 90,382,187 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 89,751,136. There have been 1,936,614 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,928,636 deaths.

In the United States there are now 22,410,294 positive cases and 374,348 deaths. Yesterday there were 22,139,273 cases and 372,522 deaths. There were 271,021 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 1,826 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 176,026 cases and there have been 1,760 deaths. The state published a statement last Friday saying that the number of deaths reported that day, which was higher than any previous day, was an error. Yesterday there had been 175,620 positive cases and 1,737 deaths. 406 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 138 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 618 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 174 in Pawnee County, 600 in Richardson County, 566 in Johnson County and 1,068 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 56,514 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,118 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,587 cases in Dawson County and 3,565 cases in Dakota County. There are now 1,899 cases in Gage County and 24,046 cases in Lancaster County.
