**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! It seems as though the big news around COVID-19 is getting the vaccine to as many people as possible. Our team is doing a wonderful job of administering as many vaccinations as possible. The process varies from county to county, so if someone from another county tells you something different than what you are hearing in our county, they may be correct. Things really vary from health district to health district so be aware of those differences as well.

We are going to start giving vaccinations to the over 75 age group today so if you see people around here this afternoon, that is what is happening. If you happen to take a phone call from someone in this age group wanting to be scheduled for a vaccination, please transfer them to Maxcey or Susi.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 91,734,304 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 91,027,775. There have been 1,965,398 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,948,146 deaths.

In the United States there are now 22,850,786 positive cases and 380,825 deaths. Yesterday there were 22,620,333 cases and 376,295 deaths. There were 230,453 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 4,530 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 177,670 cases and there have been 1,791 deaths. Yesterday there had been 176,670 positive cases and 1,772 deaths. 1,000 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 329 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 618 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 174 in Pawnee County, 600 in Richardson County, 566 in Johnson County and 1,068 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 57,099 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,156 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,591 cases in Dawson County and 3,573 cases in Dakota County. There are now 1,907 cases in Gage County and 24,348 cases in Lancaster County.
