RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, January 13th. There are 103 new cases of COVID-19 and one additional death in their area. 23 of the new cases are in Johnson County, 28 are in Nemaha County, 35 are in Otoe County, four are in Pawnee County and 13 are in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,129 cases and 39 deaths in the district. 685 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days. I didn't report the update for January 11th so the increase in cases noted here is for six days.

We had a very successful day of giving vaccinations to those in our community that are 75 and older yesterday. 40 vaccinations were given and all of the recipients that I visited with were very happy to be getting the vaccine. Channel 6 News was down again reporting on the event so we will be sharing the link to that once it becomes available.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 92,484,759 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 91,734,304. There have been 1,981,802 deaths. Yesterday there had been 1,965,398 deaths.

In the United States there are now 23,079,161 positive cases and 384,794 deaths. Yesterday there were 22,850,786 cases and 380,825 deaths. There were 228,375 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 3,969 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 179,199 cases and there have been 1,803 deaths. Yesterday there had been 177,670 positive cases and 1,791 deaths. 1,529 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 433 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 646 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 178 in Pawnee County, 613 in Richardson County, 589 in Johnson County and 1,103 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 57,532 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,247 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,599 cases in Dawson County and 3,589 cases in Dakota County. There are now 1,917 cases in Gage County and 24,544 cases in Lancaster County.
