**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Friday, January 15<sup>th</sup>. There are 37 new cases of COVID-19 and one additional death in their area. Five of the new cases are in Johnson County, nine are in Nemaha County, eight are in Otoe County, one is in Pawnee County and 14 are in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,166 cases and 40 deaths in the district. 624 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

Nebraska did not enter any new data into the database on Sunday so the data that was available today is for two days.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 95,135,784 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 94,597,012. There have been 2,032,787 deaths. Yesterday there had been 2,024,110 deaths.

In the United States there are now 23,938,288 positive cases and 397,611 deaths. Yesterday there were 23,760,523 cases and 395,855 deaths. There were 177,765 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 1,756 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 181,978 cases and there have been 1,837 deaths. Yesterday there had been 180,910 positive cases and 1,837 deaths. 1,068 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 350 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 655 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 179 in Pawnee County, 627 in Richardson County, 594 in Johnson County and 1,111 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 58,379 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,356 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,618 cases in Dawson County and 3,607 cases in Dakota County. There are now 1,952 cases in Gage County and 25,068 cases in Lancaster County.
