**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, January 20<sup>th</sup>. There are 47 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. Seven of the new cases are in Johnson County, three are in Nemaha County, 29 are in Otoe County, four are in Pawnee County and four are in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,213 cases and 40 deaths in the district. 571 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 96,984,258 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 96,284,292. There have been 2,077,803 deaths. Yesterday there had been 2,060,232 deaths.

In the United States there are now 24,441,852 positive cases and 406,196 deaths. Yesterday there were 24,255,934 cases and 401,820 deaths. There were 185,918 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 4,376 deaths.

The Nebraska information was updated today. I assume this is data for the last two days so the numbers look a little strange. In Nebraska there are now 184,482 cases and there have been 1,862 deaths. Yesterday there had been 182,176 positive cases and 1,842 deaths. 2,306 new confirmed cases have been identified in the last two days and 783 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 658 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 183 in Pawnee County, 631 in Richardson County, 601 in Johnson County and 1,140 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 59,230 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,416 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,647 cases in Dawson County and 3,623 cases in Dakota County. There are now 1,971 cases in Gage County and 25,523 cases in Lancaster County.
