**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! There is not a lot to report today. The main topic of discussion is how to get more vaccine in arms. We are seeing a very limited amount of vaccine in our area. We keep telling the powers that be to give us vaccine and we will make sure someone receives it!

As of 9:00 this morning there were 100,990,354 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 100,389,150. There have been 2,177,677 deaths. Yesterday there had been 2,160,850 deaths.

In the United States there are now 25,600,243 positive cases and 429,230 deaths. Yesterday there were 25,445,700 cases and 425,257 deaths. There were 154,543 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 3,973 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 188,784 cases and there have been 1,917 deaths. Yesterday there had been 188,122 positive cases and 1,905 deaths. 662 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 244 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 692 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 189 in Pawnee County, 648 in Richardson County, 610 in Johnson County and 1,180 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 60,621 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,564 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,671 cases in Dawson County and 3,643 cases in Dakota County. There are now 1,993 cases in Gage County and 26,393 cases in Lancaster County.
