RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Monday, February 1st. There are 34 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. Three of the new cases are in Johnson County, three are in Nemaha County, 25 are in Otoe County, one is in Pawnee County and two are in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,373 cases and 48 deaths in the district. 443 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

I want to remind our employees to not park in the area around the entrance to Cardiac Rehab. We are giving vaccinations to people that are 75 years of age and older and we need those spots for them. It seems as though parking has become a premium around here. We may have to evaluate adding to our parking lots again.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 103,523,528 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 103,043,330. There have been 2,241,147 deaths. Yesterday there had been 2,229,697 deaths.

In the United States there are now 26,332,785 positive cases and 443,636 deaths. Yesterday there were 26,188,167 cases and 441,331 deaths. There were 144,618 new cases diagnosed in the U.S. yesterday and 2,305 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 190,950 cases and there have been 1,920 deaths. Yesterday there had been 190,713 positive cases and 1,920 deaths. 237 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 85 of the new cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 702 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 191 in Pawnee County, 652 in Richardson County, 615 in Johnson County and 1,213 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 61,269 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,640 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,692 cases in Dawson County and 3,657 cases in Dakota County. There are now 2,001 cases in Gage County and 26,738 cases in Lancaster County.
