RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The number of new cases of COVID-19 continue to decline in the state. I think that there are several reasons for this but I think that the main reason is people doing what they should be doing.

Vaccinations continue to be the big news these days. I am in hopes that we receive more vaccine in the coming weeks so that more people can receive it. We have plenty of people wanting the vaccinations if we can just get the vaccine to deliver.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 106,228,180 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 105,856,046. There have been 2,318,700 deaths. Yesterday there had been 2,301,212 deaths.

In the United States there are now 27,008,560 positive cases and 463,482 deaths. Yesterday there were 26,919,361 cases and 462,181 deaths. There were 89,199 new cases diagnosed yesterday and 1,301 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 193,722 cases and there have been 1,968 deaths. Yesterday there had been 193,421 positive cases and 1,968 deaths. 301 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 70 of those cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 707 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 199 in Pawnee County, 656 in Richardson County, 623 in Johnson County and 1,240 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 62,029 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,788 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,713 cases in Dawson County and 3,665 cases in Dakota County. There are now 2,025 cases in Gage County and 27,159 cases in Lancaster County.
