RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Monday, February 8th. There are 21 new cases of COVID-19 in their area. One of the new cases is in Johnson County, two are in Nemaha County, 15 are in Otoe County, one is in Pawnee County and two are in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,445 cases and 50 deaths in the district. 348 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

We will be administering vaccinations to a group of 75+ year olds on Wednesday and Thursday so please leave the parking spots in front of the Cardiac Rehab entrance open for these folks. If you see a safety concern or other obstacle that might interfere with these people accessing our facility, please let someone know.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 106,578,933 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 106,228,180. There have been 2,327,985 deaths. Yesterday there had been 2,318,700 deaths.

In the United States there are now 27,098,933 positive cases and 465,096 deaths. Yesterday there were 27,008,560 cases and 463,482 deaths. There were 90,373 new cases diagnosed yesterday and 1,614 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 194,170 cases and there have been 1,968 deaths. Yesterday there had been 193,722 positive cases and 1,968 deaths. 448 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 43 of those cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 709 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 199 in Pawnee County, 658 in Richardson County, 624 in Johnson County and 1,255 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 62,072 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,789 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,713 cases in Dawson County and 3,665 cases in Dakota County. There are now 2,025 cases in Gage County and 27,170 cases in Lancaster County.
