**RE:** Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, February 10th. There are 24 new cases of COVID-19 and one additional death in their area. One of the new cases is in Johnson County, four are in Nemaha County, nine are in Otoe County, two are in Pawnee County and eight are in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,469 cases and 51 deaths in the district. 355 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

I was in meetings yesterday and did not get a chance to send out an update.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 107,883,016 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 107,444,504. There have been 2,370,735 deaths. Yesterday there had been 2,357,270 deaths.

In the United States there are now 27,393,896 positive cases and 475,459 deaths. Yesterday there were 27,288,291 cases and 471,764 deaths. There were 105,605 new cases diagnosed yesterday and 3,695 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 195,006 cases and there have been 1,990 deaths. Yesterday there had been 194,632 positive cases and 1,986 deaths. 374 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 129 of those cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 713 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 201 in Pawnee County, 666 in Richardson County, 625 in Johnson County and 1,264 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 62,420 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,845 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,729 cases in Dawson County and 3,675 cases in Dakota County. There are now 2,040 cases in Gage County and 27,344 cases in Lancaster County.
