Good morning! Well, it appears that no one from the state entered any new information into the database for yesterday. It also appears that the Southeast District Health Department did not update their database either. My report today will not include this information.

The big thing on the news is how to get more doses of vaccine delivered to those of us that can give it. Nebraska, as a state, is not doing well in this area. Those of us in Southeast Nebraska are not the cause of this issue. We are giving every dose that we receive.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 108,892,303 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 108,892,303. There have been 2,401,392 deaths. Yesterday there had been 2,401,392 deaths.

In the United States there are now 27,641,389 positive cases and 485,338 deaths. Yesterday there were 27,641,389 cases and 485,338 deaths. There were 53,992 new cases diagnosed yesterday and 998 deaths.

As I stated above, I have no new data for Nebraska. I will update these numbers when I get the data. We now have had 715 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 204 in Pawnee County, 667 in Richardson County, 633 in Johnson County and 1,275 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 62,847 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,901 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,737 cases in Dawson County and 3,689 cases in Dakota County. There are now 2,050 cases in Gage County and 27,540 cases in Lancaster County.
