RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Wednesday, February 17th. There are eight new cases of COVID-19 in their area. One of the new cases is in Johnson County, none are in Nemaha County, four are in Otoe County, two are in Pawnee County and one is in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,510 cases and 51 deaths in the district. 298 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

Our vaccination team continues to give every dose of vaccine we receive. We are vaccinating more people from our community that are over 65 this afternoon. Thanks to all of you that have volunteered to help!

As of 9:00 this morning there were 110,024,593 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 109,617,818. There have been 2,432,825 deaths. Yesterday there had been 2,421,592 deaths.

In the United States there are now 27,828,165 positive cases and 490,718 deaths. Yesterday there were 27,757,609 cases and 488,103 deaths. There were 70,556 new cases diagnosed yesterday and 2,615 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 197,746 cases and there have been 2,018 deaths. Yesterday there had been 197,447 positive cases and 2,004 deaths. 299 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 103 of those cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 715 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 208 in Pawnee County, 668 in Richardson County, 634 in Johnson County and 1,285 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 62,985 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,921 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,748 cases in Dawson County and 3,689 cases in Dakota County. There are now 2,052 cases in Gage County and 27,617 cases in Lancaster County.
