RE: Daily COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Friday, February 19th. There are 28 new cases of COVID-19 and two additional deaths in their area. None of the new cases are in Johnson County, 10 are in Nemaha County, 11 are in Otoe County, four are in Pawnee County and three are in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,538 cases and 53 deaths in the district. 265 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

I was out of the office attending to other matters last Friday and Saturday and did not get the chance to capture the COVID-19 data so there was no update on Friday.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 111,518,562 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 111,161,924. There have been 2,468,646 deaths. Yesterday there had been 2,462,141 deaths.

In the United States there are now 28,135,045 positive cases and 499,056 deaths. Yesterday there were 28,078,813 cases and 497,670 deaths. There were 56,232 new cases diagnosed yesterday and 1,386 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 199,045 cases and there have been 2,047 deaths. Yesterday there had been 198,751 positive cases and 2,047 deaths. 294 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 99 of those cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 725 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 212 in Pawnee County, 671 in Richardson County, 634 in Johnson County and 1,296 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 63,339 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 6,984 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,763 cases in Dawson County and 3,700 cases in Dakota County. There are now 2,072 cases in Gage County and 27,848 cases in Lancaster County.
