RE: Weekly COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department updated the information on their website on Friday, April 2nd. There are seven new cases of COVID-19 in their area. None of the new cases are in Johnson County, three are in Nemaha County, two are in Otoe County, one is in Pawnee County and one is in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,806 cases and 59 deaths in the district. 157 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

There have been some people interested in knowing the number vaccinations that have been given by our hospital. So far, we have administered 2,649 doses of vaccine. We gave 290 doses last week.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 131,419,173 cases in the world. Yesterday there were 130,897,256. There have been 2,854,842 deaths. Yesterday there had been 2,848,308 deaths.

In the United States there are now 30,706,676 positive cases and 555,002 deaths. Yesterday there were 30,672,830 cases and 554,779 deaths. There were 33,846 new cases diagnosed yesterday and 223 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 211,958 cases and there have been 2,181 deaths. Yesterday there had been 211,812 positive cases and 2,181 deaths. 146 new confirmed cases have been identified since yesterday and 89 of those cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 760 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 236 in Pawnee County, 770 in Richardson County, 645 in Johnson County and 1,395 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 67,561 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 7,601 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,860 cases in Dawson County and 3,843 cases in Dakota County. There are now 2,151 cases in Gage County and 29,885 cases in Lancaster County.
