RE: Weekly COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department has updated the information on their website. There is a total of 18 new cases in the district in the last week. None of the new cases are in Johnson County, nine are in Nemaha County, nine are in Otoe County, None are in Pawnee County and none are in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,888 cases and 61 deaths in the district. 114 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

There have been some people interested in knowing the number vaccinations that have been given by our hospital. So far, we have administered 3,300 doses of vaccine. We gave 201 doses last week. We are having a difficult time finding people willing to receive all of the vaccine that we have been allocated. We even started offering the vaccine to walk-ins last week. Please share the importance of becoming vaccinated with your friends and family.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 147,292,930 cases in the world. Last Monday there were 141,525,400. There have been 3,111,387 deaths. Last Monday there had been 3,022,126 deaths.

In the United States there are now 32,077,935 positive cases and 572,200 deaths. Last Monday there were 31,670,846 cases and 567,216 deaths. There were 407,089 new cases diagnosed last week and 4,984 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 218,832 cases and there have been 2,242 deaths. Last Monday there had been 216,613 positive cases and 2,215 deaths. 2,219 new confirmed cases have been identified in the last week and 702 of those cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 779 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 236 in Pawnee County, 778 in Richardson County, 652 in Johnson County and 1,443 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 70,218 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 7,707 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,878 cases in Dawson County and 3,903 cases in Dakota County. There are now 2,175 cases in Gage County and 30,834 cases in Lancaster County.
