RE: Weekly COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department has updated the information on their website. There is a total of 12 new cases in the district in the last week. One of the new cases was in Johnson County, four were in Nemaha County, six were in Otoe County, none were in Pawnee County and one was in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,900 cases and 61 deaths in the district. 99 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

There have been some people interested in knowing the number vaccinations that have been given by our hospital. So far, we have administered 3,376 doses of vaccine. We gave 76 doses last week. We are having a difficult time finding people willing to receive all of the vaccine that we have been allocated. We even started offering the vaccine to walk-ins last week. Please share the importance of becoming vaccinated with your friends and family.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 152,946,524 cases in the world. Last Monday there were 147,292,930. There have been 3,204,301 deaths. Last Monday there had been 3,111,387 deaths.

In the United States there are now 32,422,234 positive cases and 577,046 deaths. Last Monday there were 32,077,935 cases and 572,200 deaths. There were 344,299 new cases diagnosed last week and 4,846 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 220,127 cases and there have been 2,245 deaths. Last Monday there had been 218,832 positive cases and 2,242 deaths. 1,295 new confirmed cases have been identified in the last week and 495 of those cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 783 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 236 in Pawnee County, 779 in Richardson County, 653 in Johnson County and 1,449 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 70,713 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 7,729 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,880 cases in Dawson County and 3,914 cases in Dakota County. There are now 2,185 cases in Gage County and 31,071 cases in Lancaster County.
